of the public sector will continue to deserve critical attention. If politicians could temper their ideological inclinations more frequently by the types of analysis advocated by Mascarenhas, decision-making about public sector management is likely to be better informed.

R.J. May (ed.), Micronationalist Movements in Papua New Guinea, (Canberra: Department of Political and Social Change, Australian National University, Monograph 1, 1982), pp.x, 486, maps, illustrations. \$A9.50.

This collection of essays bears a misleading title, as some of the contributors point out (pp. 138 and 405). The editor is aware of the fact, and in his introduction attempts somewhat apologetically to justify so labelling a diverse group of "movements which displayed a common tendency, at least at an ideological or psychological level, to disengage from the wider economic and political systems imposed by colonial rule, seeking in a sense a common identity and purpose, and through some combination of traditional and modern values and organisational forms, an acceptable formula for their own development" (p. 1). Obviously movements with these characteristics need not have aims that could be considered nationalistic; in fact, the membership of some only comprised a portion of the residents of a handful of villages. Since Papua New Guinea villages usually have populations of only a few hundred, and most languages only have a few thousand speakers, it is obvious that even in those few cases involving, however temporarily, the majority of speakers of a single language, it is hard to speak of "mass movements", as is done on p. ix. Furthermore, it is not clear why May refers to the movements described in this book as among the "more important", "more significant", and "more notable" of those that appeared in Papua New Guinea during, the period under consideration, from the late 1960s to the mid 1970s (pp. ix, 1,4). Certainly the most famous movements are included, but so are small and obscure ones, such as the Pitenamu Society, "little known beyond a small group of government officials and Lutheran Church personnel" (p. 63). The reader gets the impression that some movements were chosen to provide additional examples in the categories set up by the editor, of "marginal cargo cults", "local protest movements", "self helpdevelopment movements", and "regional separatist movements".

In his introduction, May gives a brief but useful survey of other movements in Papua New Guinea, and discusses his categories (while admiting that they are "fluid"). Whether or not all of the movements in the body of the book merit detailed analysis, they certainly do illustrate a range of local reactions resulting from dissatisfaction with "that colonial creation, the state" (p. 2). At the very least, accounts of their achievements or, more often, failures contribute to an understanding of the probable course of development of similar movements both in Papua New Guinea and in other countries that face like problems of divergence between the aims of the central government and the desires of local groups. In fact, as several authors point out, in a number of cases the willingness of the first Somare government to accommodate these movements made those who had refrained from rebellion feel that they had gained less
