

They develop usually unconsciously an image of their characters or in other terms an ideal for the organization of their minds and lives which they both aspire to and project into whatever they create This character ideal appears in their works their social visions their philosophies of nature and also their understandings of creative processes their own and others What creative people wish for themselves is what they wish for in their lives and works Young Bruehl suggests that there are three broad character and creative types each comprised of many variations She displays these ways of getting one s psychic act together or getting a product together by turning to three ancient Greek theorists of creativity Plato Aristotle and Zeno and three modern theorists Nietzsche Freud and Proust She then proceeds by clustering biographical vignettes and portraits of ideas in which she can show rather than try to define the creativity as well as the character ideal she has in mind Of special interest to Young Bruehl is what individuals say about their own creativity especially when creativity is not explicitly their topic Her approach is primarily psychoanalytic but she
