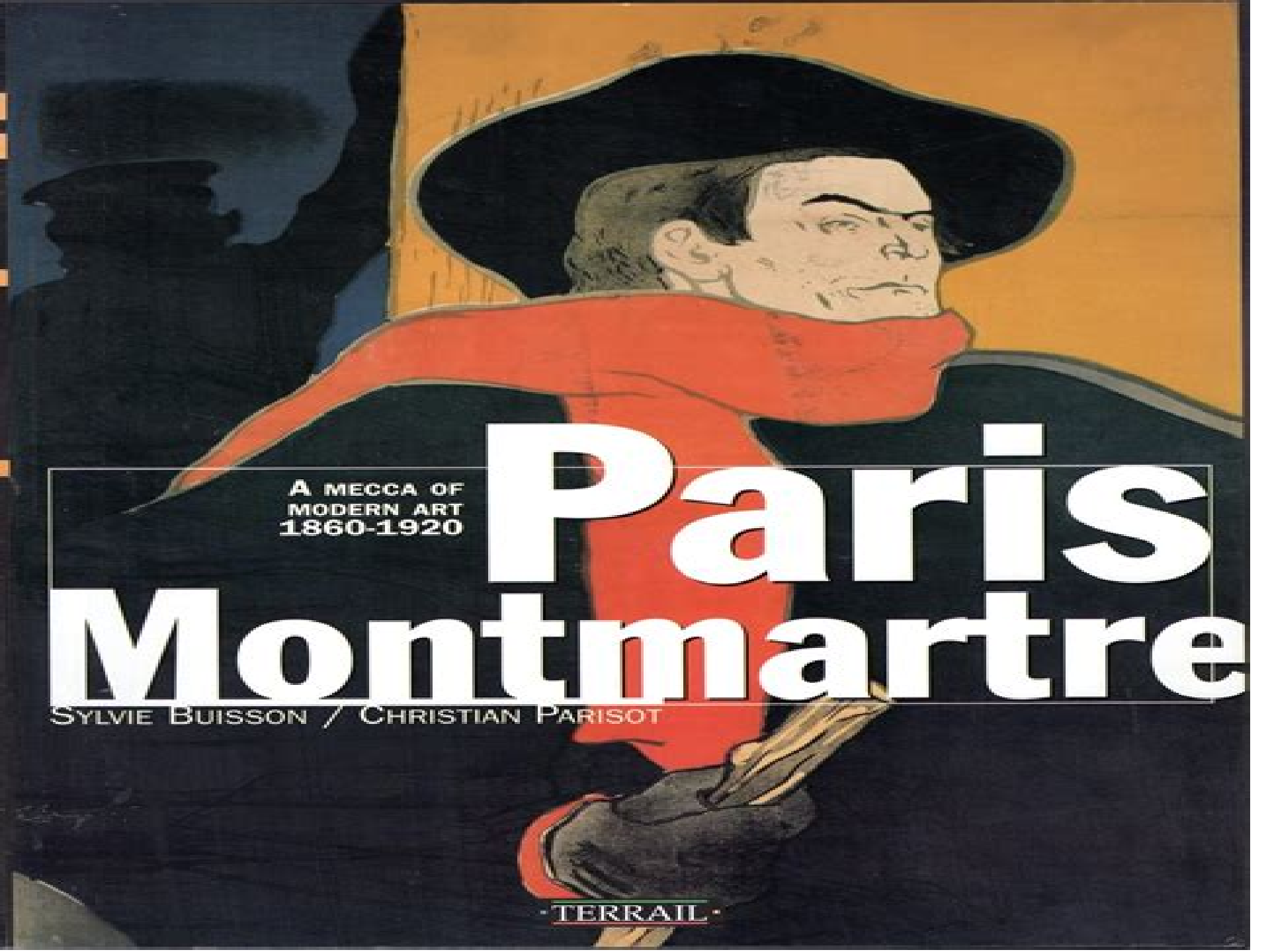




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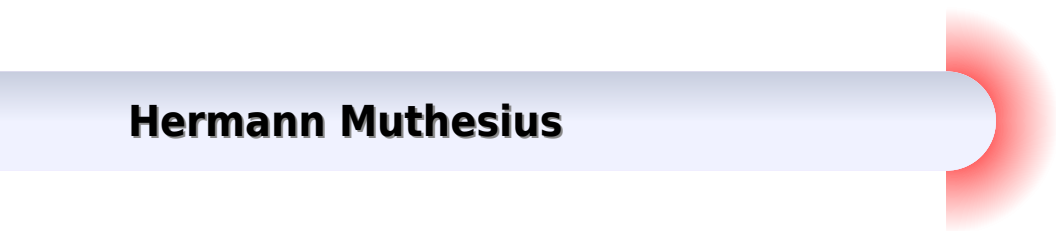

Sitte, Hegemann and the Metropolis Charles Bohl, Jean-François Lejeune, 2009-06-02 These essays from leading names in the field weave together the parallels and differences between the past and present of civic art Offering prospects for the first decades of the twenty first century the authors open up a broad international dialogue on civic art which relates historical practice to the contemporary meaning of civic art and its application to community building within today's multi cultural modern cities The volume brings together the rich perspectives on the thought practice and influence of leading figures from the great era of civic art that began in the nineteenth century and blossomed in the early twentieth century as documented in the works of Werner Hegemann and his contemporaries and considered fundamental to contemporary practice

The American Vitruvius Werner Hegemann, Elbert Peets, 1922 *Paris Montmartre* Sylvie Buisson, Christian Parisot, 1996 Between 1860 and 1920 artists flocked to take up residence in Montmartre including Degas Pissarro Renoir and Van Gogh This book sets out to tell the story of these artists and to bring back to life the successive pictorial revolutions in Montmartre

Civic Art Thomas Hayton Mawson, 1911 Style-Architecture and Building-Art Hermann Muthesius, 1994-12-15 Style Architecture and Building Art is Hermann Muthesius's classic criticism of nineteenth century architecture Now published for the first time in English this pivotal text represents the first serious effort by Muthesius to define the elements of early modernist architecture according to notions of realism and simplicity Although Muthesius is known best in Anglo American architectural literature for his studies of the English house his scholarship constituted a wide ranging modernist polemic emanating from the German realist movement of the late 1890s Notions that were introduced in Style Architecture and Building Art became common in later modernist historiography disdain for the nineteenth century's artistic eclecticism and lack of originality appreciation of the material and industrial aspects of building technology and above all a simpler approach to design Muthesius critique of stylistic architecture is not only linked to the development of the Deutsche Werkbund movement but also can be viewed more broadly as a cornerstone of the modern movement In his introduction Stanford Anderson situates Muthesius and his work in turn of the century architectural discourse and analyzes his vision of a new form of architecture Anderson also discusses the rationale underlying the call for cultural renewal the role of English architectural models in Muthesius's thought critical differences between the first and second editions of Style Architecture and Building Art the influence of the Jugendstil and Art Nouveau movements on Muthesius and in turn the influence of Muthesius on the Deutsche Werkbund movement

Modern Architecture and the Mediterranean Jean-François Lejeune, Michelangelo Sabatino, 2009-12-04 Considering the influence of the forms and tectonics of the Mediterranean vernacular on modern architectural practice and discourse from the 1920s to the 1960s AIA Guide to the Architecture of Atlanta Gerald W. Sams, 1993 This lively guidebook surveys four hundred buildings within the Atlanta metropolitan area from the sleek marble and glass of the Coca Cola Tower to the lancet arches and onion domes of the Fox

Theater from the quiet stateliness of Roswell's antebellum mansions to the art deco charms of the Varsity grill Published in conjunction with the Atlanta chapter of the American Institute of Architects it combines historical descriptive and critical commentary with more than 250 photographs and area maps As the book makes clear Atlanta has two faces the Traditional City striving to strike a balance between the preservation of a valuable past and the challenge of modernization and also the Invisible Metropolis a decentralized city shaped more by the isolated ventures of private business than by public intervention Accordingly the city's architecture reflects a dichotomy between the northern emulating boosterism that made Atlanta a boom town and the genteel aesthetic more characteristic of its southern locale The city's recent development continues the trend as Atlanta's workplaces become increasingly high tech its residential areas remain resolutely traditional In the book's opening section Dana White places the different stages of Atlanta's growth from its beginnings as a railroad town to its recent selection as the site of the 1996 Summer Olympics in their social cultural and economic context Isabelle Gournay then analyzes the major urban and architectural trends from a critical perspective The main body of the book consists of more than twenty architectural tours organized according to neighborhoods or districts such as Midtown Druid Hills West End Ansley Park and Buckhead The buildings described and pictured capture the full range of architectural styles found in the city Here are the prominent new buildings that have transformed Atlanta's skyline and neighborhoods Philip John and John Burgee's revivalist IBM Tower John Portman's taut Westin Peachtree Plaza and Richard Meier's gleaming white paneled High Museum of Art among others Here too are landmarks from another era such as the elegant residences designed in the early twentieth century by Neel Reid and Philip Shutze two of the first Atlanta based architects to achieve national prominence Included as well are the eclectic skyscrapers near Five Points the postmodern office clusters along Interstate 285 and the Victorian homes of Inman Park Easy to follow area maps complement the descriptive entries and photographs a bibliography glossary and indexes to buildings and architects round out the book Whether first time visitors or lifelong residents readers will find in these pages a wealth of fascinating information about Atlanta's built environment

film *From the Other Side* Also included is a revised translation of Spanish King Philip II's influential planning treatise of 1573 the *Laws of the Indies* which did so much to define the form of the Latin American city **Paris on the Potomac** Cynthia R. Field, Isabelle Gournay, Thomas P. Somma, 2013-02-04 In 1910 John Mervin Carr, a Paris-trained American architect wrote *Learning from Paris* made Washington outstanding among American cities The five essays in *Paris on the Potomac* explore aspects of this influence on the artistic and architectural environment of Washington D C which continued long after the well known contributions of Peter Charles L'Enfant the transplanted French military officer who designed the city's plan Isabelle Gournay's introductory essay provides an overview and examines the context and issues involved in three distinct periods of French influence the classical and Enlightenment principles that prevailed from the 1790s through the 1820s the Second Empire style of the 1850s through the 1870s and the Beaux Arts movement of the early twentieth century William C Allen and Thomas P Somma present two case studies Allen on the influence of French architecture especially the Halle aux Blés on Thomas Jefferson's vision of the U S Capitol and Somma on David d'Angers's busts of George Washington and the Marquis de Lafayette Liana Paredes offers a richly detailed examination of French inspired interior decoration in the homes of Washington's elite in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries Cynthia R Field concludes the volume with a consideration of the influence of Paris on city planning in Washington D C including the efforts of the McMillan Commission and the later development of the Federal Triangle complex The essays in this collection the latest addition to the series *Perspectives on the Art and Architectural History of the United States Capitol* originated in a conference held by the U S Capitol Historical Society in 2002 at the French Embassy's Maison Française **Hegemann and Peets American Vitruvius** Werner Hegemann, Elbert Peets, 1988 *American Vitruvius: an Architects Handbook of Civic Art* At the end of the second decade of this the twentieth century Werner Hegemann a German born urban planning theorist and practitioner and Elbert Peets a young American recently graduated from Harvard University's School of Landscape Architecture joined together in Wisconsin in a professional partnership The association of these two students of American urbanism culminated in 1922 with *The American Vitruvius: an Architects Handbook of Civic Art* a critical text that played an essential role in the definition and promotion of modern American city planning *American Vitruvius* offers the reader an atlas of design solutions and advocates a humanistic as well as rational development of the urban environment Princeton Architectural Press has reprinted the entire original text including the book's 1203 plates These illustrations consist of plans elevations and perspective views of both European and American cities spanning in date from the Renaissance to the twentieth century The republication of this volume suggests the relevance of Hegemann and Peets' approach for contemporary city planning Today in the midst of an era responding to the dehumanization of the city *American Vitruvius* offers a reconciliation of artistic aspects of civic art with scientific theory of city planning the authors insist upon a city that allows its residents both pleasure and freedom of expression Front flap *non art 1971-2000* Burkhardt Leitner, 2002-08-27 **Camillo Sitte** George R.
