visually repulsive Rules of conduct dating back to Antiquity disapproved of the opening of the mouth to express feelings in most social situations Open and unrestrained smiling was associated with the impolite lower orders In late eighteenth century Paris however these age old conventions changed reflecting broader transformations in the way people expressed their feelings This allowed the emergence of the modern smile par excellence the open mouthed smile which while highlighting physical beauty and expressing individual identity revealed white teeth It was a transformation linked to changing patterns of politeness new ideals of sensibility shifts in styles of self presentation and not least the emergence of scientific dentistry These changes seemed to usher in a revolution a revolution in smiling Yet if the French revolutionaries initially went about their business with a smile on their faces the Reign of Terror soon wiped it off Only in the twentieth century would the white tooth smile re emerge as an accepted model of self presentation.
