weaves the magical with the mundane in a wholly delightful often hilarious look at what it was to be an American family man in Paris at the end of the twentieth century We went to Paris for a sentimental reeducation I did anyway even though the sentiments we were instructed in were not the ones we were expecting to learn which I believe is why they call it an education
