- Diseases
  - Fifth disease (cutaneous rash)
  - Transient aplastic crisis (severe acute anemia)
  - Pure red cell aplasia (chronic anemia)
  - Hydrops fetalis (fatal fetal anemia)
  - B19 virus most common
- Fifth Disease
  - Targets red blood cell progenitors
  - Pain in joints
  - Results in lysis of cells, thus depleting source of mature red cells
  - Anemia ensues
  - Rarely fatal and without complications
