hedonism and showing how they evade some of the objections He also shows how it is possible to develop forms of hedonism that are equivalent to the allegedly anti hedonistic theory of G E Moore and the Aristotelian theory according to which the Good Life is the life of virtue or flourishing He also formulates hedonisms relevantly like the ones defended by Aristippus and Mill Feldman argues that a carefully developed form of attitudinal hedonism is not refuted by objections concerning the shape of a life He also defends the claim that all of the alleged forms of hedonism discussed in the book genuinely deserve to be called hedonism Finally after dealing with the last of the objections he gives a sketch of his hedonistic vision of the Good Life
