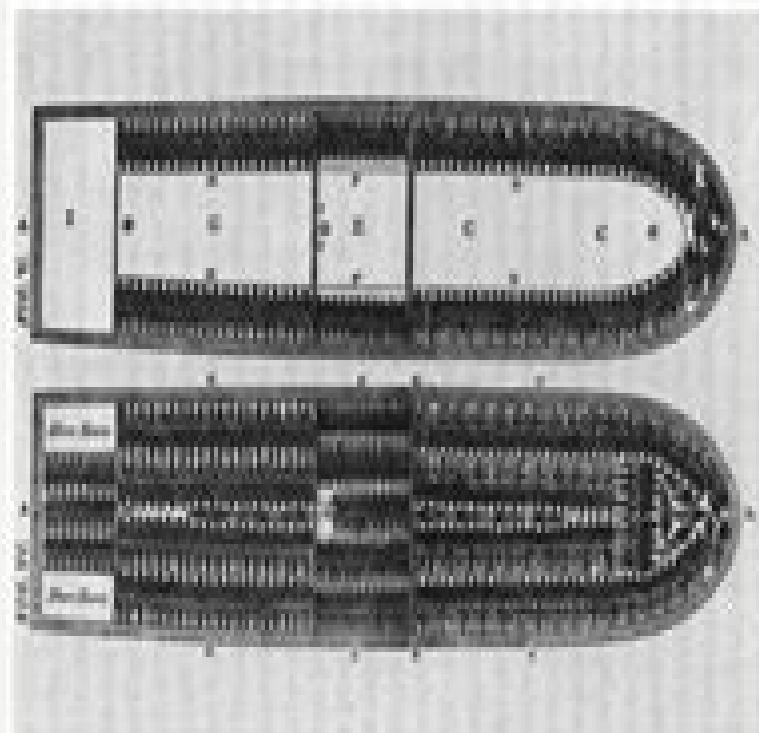


THE MIDDLE PASSAGE
