Cultures of the Popular in the Modern Hispanic World Alison Sinclair, 2024-12-10 How many cassette tapes do you still own In one hundred years how many TikTok videos or Instagram posts will still be accessible Yet much of today's news and mass culture is produced and disseminated via transient means Just as in previous eras Hispanic popular cultures of previous centuries once intended for a broad audience can now only be glimpsed in fragile and frequently overlooked media such as chapbooks newspapers journals and early sound recordings This bilingual collection explores aspects of the ephemeral cultures of Spain and Latin America between the sixteenth and twentieth centuries taking advantage of the recent digital turn in the humanities The first section examines the varied audiences for mass literature in Spain and the authorities attempts to censor and control it The second looks at pliegos sueltos songbooks and collections of popular poetry in Argentina Mexico and Chile The third section concentrates on questions of performance studying placards which originally accompanied oral readings of pliegos sueltos news ballads and zarzuelas The volume concludes with a focus on three case studies the travels of an eighteenth century giant and the reception of his self-fashioning in Spain the diffusion of the works of a Spanish pulp novelist in Portugal and Brazil and the revival of a Peruvian festival of popular music in the early twentieth century Throughout the chapters show how the increasing digitisation of library and archival collections has enabled much of this ephemeral material to be discovered analysed and compared leading to new understandings of how popular culture developed and migrated and indeed what is meant by popular *Subject Catalog* Library of Congress, 1982 *Life Writing*

Landscaping Patagonia María de los Ángeles Picone, 2025-02-11 In late nineteenth century Latin America governments used new scientific technological and geographical knowledge not only to consolidate power and protect borders but also to define the physical contours of their respective nations Chilean and Argentine authorities in particular attempted to transform northern Patagonia a space they perceived as desert through a myriad of nationalizing policies from military campaigns to hotels But beyond the urban governing halls of Chile and Argentina explorers migrants local authorities bandits and visitors also made sense of the nation by inhabiting the physical space of the northern Patagonian Andes They surveyed passes opened roads claimed land titles or leases traveled miles to the nearest police station rode miles on horseback to escape the police and hiked the landscape Mar a de los ngeles Picone tells the story of how people living governing and traveling through northern Patagonia sought to construct versions of Chile and Argentina based on their ideas about and experiences in geographical space in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries By repositioning the analytical focus from Santiago and Buenos Aires to northern Patagonia Picone reveals how a wide array of actors with varying degrees of political economic and social power assigned distinctive and sometimes conflicting meanings to space and national identity

con los pueblos originarios poseedores de una tradición educativa milenaria. En estos territorios no hubo presencia estatal permanente hasta la instalación de la primera colonia estable en 1865. La educación formal se inicia entonces a partir de allí con las escuelas galesas. La primera escuela nacional se instala en Rawson en el año 1878 en el momento en que se crea la Gobernación de la Patagonia. Recién en 1892 se abre la primera escuela laica congregacionista salesiana que se consolida en 1893. No media aquí la educación colonial sino que se pasa de manera abrupta de una educación originaria a una educación formal. En el año 1881 se crea el Consejo Nacional de Educación y en 1884 se sanciona la nueva Ley N° 1420 de Educación. Comenzó en el mismo año que se crea el Territorio Nacional del Chubut. Este es el momento en que se implementa el proyecto de consolidación del Estado nacional. El mismo fue acompañado por la construcción del sistema educativo argentino de acuerdo a las ideas de Domingo F. Sarmiento. La educación fue un objetivo central de los gobiernos de Mitre, Sarmiento, Avellaneda y la generación del 80. El proceso por el cual se funda y consolida esta construcción coincide con el momento de la fundación de las primeras escuelas estatales y del Territorio del Chubut. La educación originaria tiene dos claros momentos: el previo al establecimiento de la primera colonia permanente en el territorio y el segundo a partir de los cambios que se producen con la instalación de las primeras escuelas de educación formal. Sabemos que independientemente de la educación formal, los pueblos Mapuche, Tehuelche han mantenido de forma independiente sus prácticas culturales a través de lo que hoy denominan educación autónoma. Con el primer establecimiento permanente de colonos galeses en el territorio y el inicio de las primeras escuelas de educación formal, algunas de las tensiones entre la Colonia y las políticas estatales se disputaron también en el ámbito educativo. Los galeses generaron sus libros y tenían sus maestros pero siempre en su propia lengua, considerada como un don de Dios. Ante el avance de las escuelas estatales y de la castellanización, crearon la primera escuela intermedia para poder sostener la educación de sus jóvenes en la lengua galesa, el idioma del cielo. Entre 1878 y 1916 se va estructurando y consolidando el poder normalizador del Consejo Nacional de Educación y aumenta la implementación de los mecanismos de estadísticas y control a través de los inspectores. Muchos de ellos se tuvieron que adaptar a las realidades locales. Los inspectores del Consejo Nacional de Educación en los Territorios Nacionales como figuras visibles del gobierno central fueron también muchas veces nexo entre este y las demandas de los territorios en muchos casos en temas que trascendían lo educativo. Se cree que la instalación de la escuela colabora en el arraigo de los pobladores en continuidad con el proyecto sarmientino de poblamiento. La escuela fue el lugar privilegiado de producción de la nación, fortalecer a él, el rol del Estado y actuar como instrumento de integración de estos sujetos produciendo la homogeneidad. Vemos entonces cómo se va imbricando el nacimiento de algunas colonias con la creación de escuelas. La escuela en el territorio como base de la presencia del Estado, modificar a las conductas de los habitantes, luego vendrá el juez y la policía como poder estatal. En el inicio de este proceso, el inspector y la escuela cumplen un rol fundamental. El punto de partida de la presencia de la Congregación Salesiana es un suceso que ve como un aviso celeste o revelación. A partir de 1876 tiene el proyecto de establecer

una colonia italiana en una zona comprendida entre el río Negro y el estrecho de Magallanes para facilitar la evangelización de los indios y de ayudar eficazmente a los emigrados italianos abandonados a sí mismos. Es así que comienza un complejo entramado político para establecer las misiones en la Patagonia que se concretan con las misiones y escuelas salesianas a partir de 1892 en el Chubut. En 1897 ya funciona una escuela en la cordillera y en los siguientes 15 años se establecen escuelas en la mayoría de las concentraciones de población en el territorio. En 1914 se crean las escuelas ambulantes que tienen por objeto principal combatir el analfabetismo donde la escuela fija es imposible pues no existe población concentrada. Allí solo se enseña por cuatro meses y medio y se puede ampliar a nueve donde no se habla castellano. Estas escuelas funcionan hasta 1925. En 1918 ya había escuelas en casi todos los puntos del territorio. Los conflictos relacionados con los sistemas de creencias y la educación fueron muy intensos en los primeros años del territorio. Las escuelas formales en estas disputas se acusaban unas a otras de ser sectarias. Más allá de estas diferencias en que se ponían en juego los intereses y el poder de los algunos colectivos, el proyecto político más amplio era común y compartido. En el Chubut, en donde la tradición católica apostólica romana era solo incipiente a través de la congregación salesiana, las ideas del liberalismo laicista de la época encuentran su espacio a través de la masonería.
