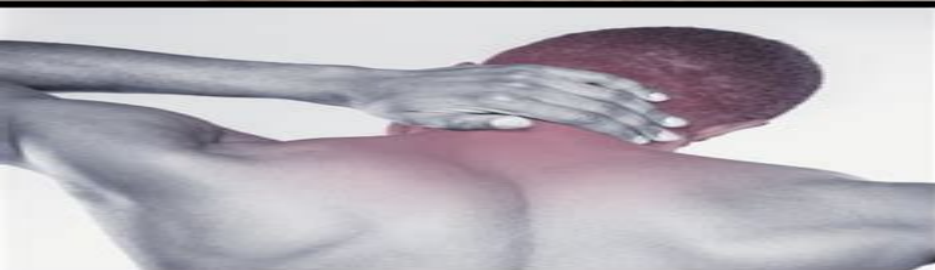


WHAT ARE THE 4 STAGES OF RHEUMATOID ARTHRITIS?

MODERATE

In the moderate stage, patients often experience more severe symptoms.



SEVERE RA

At this stage, the RA has progressed significantly. Patients experience more severe pain and frequent joint inflammation.



END STAGE

This is the end stage or the most severe stage of RA. In this stage, joint tissue inflammation reduces significantly.

SSI provides income assistance for disabled blind and aged people who have limited income and resources regardless of their prior participation in the labor force. Both programs share a common disability determination process administered by SSA and state agencies as well as a common definition of disability for adults: the inability to engage in any substantial gainful activity by reason of any medically determinable physical or mental impairment which can be expected to result in death or which has lasted or can be expected to last for a continuous period of not less than 12 months. Disabled workers might receive either SSDI benefits or SSI payments or both depending on their recent work history and current income and assets.
