The Global Economy

- The global economy provides the framework in which all national economies operate.
 - All of the economies in the world, producing goods and services, contributing to Gross World Product (GWP). Hence, a change in one economy has ripple effects on others.
 - GWP is the total value of all G&S produced in the global economy each year (3.7% growth rate in 2018).

INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC INTEGRATION:

The Global Economy

- The growth of the global economy is broadly due to;
 - 1. Deregulation of consumer and financial markets
 - 2. Increased meters and acquisitions of TNCs (transnational corporations)
 - 3. Increased communication due to the internet and satellite communication
 - Bilateral (2 countries) and multilateral (2+ countries) agreements between economies
 - 5. Movement towards privatisation
- Economic integration refers to the liberalisation of trade between two or more countries, or many countries within a region, leading to the possible formation of:
 - A Free Trade Area where a group of countries come together and abolish trade restrictions between themselves but retain restrictions against non-member countries, e.g. NAFTA (North-American Free Trade Agreement- US, Canada, Mexico)
 - A Customs Union where member countries not only abolish trade restrictions between themselves, but also adopt a common set of trade restrictions against non-member countries.
 - e.g. European Economic Community
 - A Common Market features of a customs union, additionally allowing the free mobility of labour and capital within common market countries, as well as the free flow of G&S
 - A Monetary Union features of a common market plus the adoption of a common currency and the coordination of monetary policy through a single central bank, e.g. European Union.
- Advanced Economies are market-based economies (limited government intervention), who
 dominate GWP (41.9%), have high levels of economic development (avg. per capita incomes
 >US\$30,000 p.a.) & slower economic growth with service-based industries (e.g. USA, Australia)
- Emerging and developing economies are in the process of raising their rates of economic growth
 and development, but have <u>lower per capita incomes and living standards than adv. economies</u>. These
 include economies in transition (former communist countries)
 - Emerging economies are those undergoing rapid industrialization, rapid growth and development (e.g. BRIC)
 - Developing economies are heavily reliant on agriculture and (in extreme cases) foreign aid. They
 have low income levels with a large proportion of the population in absolute poverty (< \$U\$1.25 a
 day), e.g. Ethiopia, Zimbabwe.
- The size of the global economy is measured by the International monetary Fund (IMF) through the compilation of data which values countries' Gross Domestic Products (GDPs) at purchasing power parities (PPP).
