**A**n unusual international and interdisciplinary symposium took place in Vancouver this year. The title itself, "Reinventing Fisheries Management", suggests that the topic would reach beyond present day paradigms as indeed they did. The intention, through appropriate choice of speakers and participants, was to bring together ecology, social sciences, economics, natural resource and population science to focus on innovative scientific tools, novel insights, new systems and novel forms of management that may lead to sustainable and sustainable fisheries in the 21st century. Over 100 scientists from 12 countries participated.

The reputation of Fisheries scientists has recently suffered a serious downturn. Despite our best efforts, fisheries worldwide have become severely depleted and, along with reductions in the size of fish harvested, fish communities have shifted towards small, rapidly growing species.

These symptoms have been accompanied by a crisis of fisheries confidence that has not only been largely undirected by our most advanced management methods, but has also brought about disastrous social and economic consequences. Such disasters have even occurred in developed nations like Canada, that previously leads the world in

numbers of top-rate fisheries scientists per capita.
