

**El cuento español en el siglo XX** Epicteto Díaz Navarro, José Ramón González García, 2002 Este libro propone al lector mediante la revisión de un corpus textual ampliamente representativo un acercamiento panorámico a los principales autores y tendencias del cuento literario español en el siglo XX. Es pues y sobre todo una útil herramienta informativa que permite apreciar la riqueza y la variedad de un género que carecía hasta el momento de un estudio sintético que proporcionase una visión de conjunto.

En este sentido aspira a cubrir un vacío bibliográfico ofreciendo un mapa general con el que iniciar un recorrido crítico capaz de valorar lo que la crítica del cuento ha dado de sí en la España de los últimos cien años. Por otra parte la particular atención que presta a los procedimientos narrativos y a las fórmulas propias desarrolladas por cada uno de los autores estudiados apunta posibles vías de acercamiento y sirve de orientación a quien desee profundizar en el conocimiento de una obra o de un periodo determinado

**Am I a Monkey?** Francisco J. Ayala, 2010-10-01 Despite the ongoing cultural controversy in America evolution remains a cornerstone of science. In this book Francisco J. Ayala, an evolutionary biologist member of the National Academy of Sciences and winner of the National Medal of Science and the Templeton Prize, cuts to the chase in a daring attempt to address in nontechnical language six perennial questions about evolution: Am I a Monkey? Why Is Evolution a Theory? What Is DNA? Do All Scientists Accept Evolution? How Did Life Begin? Can One Believe in Evolution and God? This top-of-the-point book answers each of these questions with force. Ayala's occasionally biting essays refuse to lend credence to disingenuous ideas and arguments. He lays out the basic science that underlies evolutionary theory, explains how the process works and soundly makes the case for why evolution is not a threat to religion.
