Violence Against Queer People Doug Meyer, 2015-10-11 Violence against lesbians and gay men has increasingly captured media and scholarly attention But these reports tend to focus on one segment of the LGBT community white middle class men and largely ignore that part of the community that arguably suffers a larger share of the violence racial minorities the poor and women In Violence against Queer People sociologist Doug Meyer offers the first investigation of anti queer violence that focuses on the role played by race class and gender Drawing on interviews with forty
