### **Queer People:**

Violence Against Queer People Doug Meyer, 2015-10-11 Violence against lesbians and gay men has increasingly captured media and scholarly attention But these reports tend to focus on one segment of the LGBT community white middle class men and largely ignore that part of the community that arguably suffers a larger share of the violence racial minorities the poor and women In Violence against Queer People sociologist Doug Meyer offers the first investigation of anti queer violence that focuses on the role played by race class and gender Drawing on interviews with forty seven victims of violence Meyer shows that LGBT people encounter significantly different forms of violence and perceive that violence quite differently based on their race class and gender His research highlights the extent to which other forms of discrimination including racism and sexism shape LGBT people s experience of abuse He reports for instance that lesbian and transgender women often described violent incidents in which a sexual or a misogynistic component was introduced and that LGBT people of color sometimes weren t sure if anti queer violence was based solely on their sexuality or whether racism or sexism had also played a role Meyer observes that given the many differences in how anti queer violence is experienced the present media focus on white middle class victims greatly oversimplifies and distorts the nature of anti-queer violence.
