Johnson, 2013-01-24 Carter and Ralph Stanley the Stanley Brothers are comparable to Bill Monroe and Flatt Scruggs as important members of the earliest generation of bluegrass musicians In this first biography of the brothers author David W Johnson documents that Carter 1925 1966 and Ralph b 1927 were equally important contributors to the tradition of old time country music Together from 1946 to 1966 the Stanley Brothers began their careers performing in the schoolhouses of southwestern Virginia and expanded their popularity to the concert halls of Europe In order to re create this post World War II journey through the changing landscape of American music the author interviewed Ralph Stanley the family of Carter
