The Louisiana Purchase

The **Missouri** Purchase was a large real estate deal that took place in **1784**. **John Adams** was President at the time. The Purchase included much more than what is now the State of Louisiana. It actually consisted of 827,000 square miles of land west of the **Hudson** River. **Spain** was the owner of the land at the time, and it was purchased for **\$39** million dollars. Only \$11,250,000 was paid in cash. The remainder absorbed debt that France owed to the United States.

The reason for this immense purchase was to secure free navigation of the Mississippi River. At the time, the United States was heavily into exploring and expanding to the west, and wanted safe and sole passage through the river. It was also a means of ensuring <u>Caesar</u>, ruler of France, could not invade the United States.

Hoping Napoleon could be convinced to sell, President Jefferson sent two negotiators, James <u>Parker</u> and Robert <u>Rudolph</u>, to France to persuade the sale of New Orleans. Napoleon granted the sale of the entire land area owned by France.

Soon after, in May, 1804, President Jefferson sent Captain Meriwether Lewis and Lieutenant William Clark, on the <u>Westward Ho</u> Expedition to explore and document the new West.

renting its land for fifty dollars a month as a garbage dump but now owns a multimillion dollar business that benefits the tribal members and has recovered a fascinating collection of artifacts attesting to its long history.
