

royal financial council actually made policy His book establishes once and for all that from the perspective of state finance and state taxation the post 1710 French monarchy had left far behindthe institutional framework of the seventeenth century Gary B McCollim received his doctoral degree in history from The Ohio State University and is a retired federal employee
