Sara McDougall, 2012-03-14 The institution of marriage is commonly thought to have fallen into crisis in late medieval northern France While prior scholarship has identified the pervasiveness of clandestine marriage as the cause Sara McDougall contends that the pressure came overwhelmingly from the prevalence of remarriage in violation of the Christian ban on divorce a practice we might call bigamy Throughout the fifteenth century in Christian Europe husbands and wives married to absent or distant spouses found new spouses to wed In the church courts of northern France many of the individuals so married were criminally prosecuted In *Bigamy and Christian Identity in Late Medieval Champagne* McDougall traces the history of this conflict in the diocese of Troyes and places it in the larger context of Christian theology and culture Multiple marriage was both inevitable and repugnant in a Christian world that forbade divorce and associated bigamy with the unchristian practices of Islam or Judaism The prevalence of bigamy might seem to suggest a failure of Christianization in late medieval northern France but careful study of the sources shows otherwise Clergy and laity alike valued marriage highly Indeed some members of the laity placed such a high value on the institution that they were willing to risk criminal punishment by entering into illegal remarriage The risk was great the Bishop of Troyes's judicial court prosecuted bigamy with unprecedented severity although this prosecution broke down along gender lines The court treated male bigamy and only male bigamy as a grave crime while female bigamy was almost completely excluded from harsh punishment As this

suggests the Church was primarily concerned with imposing a high standard on men as heads of Christian households responsible for their own behavior and also that of their wives

Schildgen argues that in addition to divine justice Dante explores how the human system of justice as exemplified in both canon and civil law and based on natural law and legal concepts of human freedom was consistently violated in the society of his era. At the same time the redemptive violence of the Crucifixion understood by Dante as the free act of God in choosing the Incarnation and death on the cross provides the model for self sacrifice for the communal good. This study primarily focused on Dante's representation of his contemporary reality demonstrates that the punishments and rewards in Dante's heaven and hell while ostensibly a staging of his vision of eternal justice may in fact be a direct appeal to his readers to recognize the crimes that pervade their own world. In one of his sermons the medieval preacher Bernardino of Siena listed seven fathers to whom one owed obedience: God, one's natural father, godfather, confessor, benefactor, a government official, and any elderly man. This book seeks to answer the question of why medieval Europeans saw the need for so many fathers. Why was fatherhood so appealing as a metaphor? Situated at the intersection of social and cultural history, the study draws upon a variety of late medieval and early modern sources including witness depositions, personal letters, and pedagogical treatises from the city of Basel, Switzerland. The book argues that it was precisely fatherhood's basis in lived experience that gave it a familiar shape in the several roles that fathers played, including provision, affection, disciplinary authority, and education. The most potent rhetorical aspect of fatherhood, however, was not as a static image or shape but rather the possibility of invoking connections between one role and another. The most potent connection between roles was the idea that fathers were affectionate authorities combining power over subordinates with desire for their well-being. Tracing the connections and contradictions of these identities, this study provides a nuanced view of concepts of fatherhood on the eve of the Reformation.

Childhood, Orphans and Underage Heirs in Medieval Rural England Miriam Müller, 2018-12-12
