**Reaping the Whirlwind** Robert Jefferson Norrell, 2013-02-13 Bringing us close to the complex history of the civil rights movement in the American South the currents that involved thousands of communities and millions of individual lives this book looks deeply into the experiences of a single Alabama town Tuskegee and its surrounding Macon County It is based on interviews with the people white and black liberal and traditional whose lives were caught up in the movement and altered forever We see Tuskegee in the early 1940s seat of America's most venerable institute of high education for blacks an important symbol of black progress yet almost entirely controlled by a white power structure and we see the emergence of a charismatic leader Charles G. Gomillion who defied Tuskegee Institute's apolitical traditions and inspired blacks to organize for their right to vote Thus begins decades of struggle which Robert J. Norrell re-creates for us through the testimony of the people who lived and shaped this history the dramatic appearance before a U.S. congressional committee of local civil rights leaders and ordinary farmers bearing witness to the seemingly endless obstructions to block voter registration the months long boycott of white Tuskegee merchants that was sparked by the city council's attempt to exclude black voters by gerrymandering the fiercely controversial move to integrate the public schools that culminated in Governor George Wallace's order to state troopers to prevent the opening of Tuskegee High the anguish that accompanied efforts by blacks to penetrate all white church congregations Norrell describes how blacks entered and won local elections including those for mayor and sheriff and how with the onset of heightened activism in the late 1960s Gomillion and other established leaders of the civil rights movement heard angry youthful voices raised against their cautious approach *Reaping the Whirlwind* carries us through the early 1970s to a community profoundly changed proud to have shed its false air of harmony gradually coming to terms with the disorder and dissension of the preceding years It is a moving and significant chronicle that documents a critical era in the nation's history

*An Ex-colored Church* Raymond R. Sommerville, 2004 The Christian

Methodist Episcopal Church was an important part of the historic freedom struggles of African Americans from Reconstruction to the Civil Rights movement. This fight for equality and freedom can be seen clearly in the denomination's evolving social and ecumenical consciousness. The denomination's very name changed from Colored to Christian in 1954, but the denomination did not join the struggle late. Rather, the CME was a critical participant from the days following the Civil War. At times the Church was at odds with their white Methodist counterparts and in solidarity with other African American denominations on issues of racial desegregation and the role of social protest in religion. Raymond Sommerville's important book discusses the relationship between Martin Luther King Jr. and the Southern Christian Leadership Conference and the CME. While King and others received most of the headlines during the Civil Rights Era, the CME proved to be involved at all levels and equally important in all they did. With its strategic location in the South and its long history of ecumenical involvement, the CME Church emerged as a leading advocate of ecumenical civil rights activism. Previous interpretations asserted that the CME was apolitical and accommodationist or that it was more progressive than it was. Sommerville presents a more nuanced account of how a church of largely former slaves emancipated itself from the constraints of white Methodist paternalism and Jim Crow racism to emerge as a progressive force of racial justice and ecumenism in the South and beyond. Sommerville examines major centers of the CME: Nashville, Birmingham, Memphis, Atlanta, and selected leaders in the South, in charting the gradual metamorphosis of the former CME as a largely nonpolitical body of former slaves in 1870 to a more politically active denomination at the apex of the modern Civil Rights movement in the 1960s.

*The Civil Rights Movement in American Memory* Renee Christine Romano, Leigh Raiford, 2006. *Physicians for the People* Jack D. Ellis, 2025 African Americans have always fared worse than whites in enjoying the benefits of material progress and medical discovery Black sociologist and civil rights leader W E B Du Bois argued that high mortality rates among Black people were rooted not in racial inferiority but in the conditions of life a fact illustrated by tuberculosis which was three times higher among Blacks than whites as well as the infant mortality rate for nonwhite children which was 149.7 deaths per 1,000 births as opposed to 92.8 per 1,000 for white children In *Physicians for the People: Black Doctors and the Struggle for Health Care Equality in Alabama, 1870-1970* Jack D. Ellis argues that the post Civil War lives of Black physicians dentists pharmacists nurses and midwives hold special significance in this regard illuminating both the causes of health care disparities among African Americans and the reasons for their continued underrepresentation in the medical professions At the center of Ellis's study are African American doctors who practiced in Alabama between the late 1870s and the Civil Rights movement of the 1960s During those years a total of 241 Black medical graduates passed their licensing examinations and opened offices in the state Ellis poses these questions What were their geographical and family origins and why had they been attracted to the study of medicine Where had they trained and how did they manage to function as professionals in a climate of racial oppression What was their relationship to white doctors practicing in their communities and how did they compensate for their systematic exclusion from local medical societies and hospitals To identify Alabama's Black doctors of the past Ellis first turns to the annual membership lists of each medical society in the state's sixty-seven counties where the names of licensed practitioners who were not members also appeared followed by the abbreviation col for colored a routine practice of the era that only ceased in 1965 Ellis then compiles oral histories from various interviews with physicians dentists and family members who were able to provide information on conditions affecting African American medical practice in Alabama between the 1930s and 1970s Portions of these oral histories include doctors' recollections of childhood family life and early education and their evolving interest in the sciences which occurred despite the weakness of libraries and laboratories in Black schools Also included are the doctors' memories of medical training and the problems they encountered once in practice from the wholesale poverty of their patients to the parallel worlds in which Black and white practitioners pursued their calling as well as their accounts of the years spent trying to gain admission to Alabama's county medical societies where membership was required to be admitted to hospital staffs and to pursue specialty training As Ellis shows this proved to be the hardest battle of all even though Black doctors had passed the same licensing examinations as white doctors From their first appearance in Alabama Black physicians hoped to cooperate with their white peers but their efforts went largely ignored white doctors tended not only to share the racist

norms of their time but often exceeded them Black doctors being denied hospital training came at an enormous price to their careers and to the health of the state s Black citizens the effects of which can still be seen today in statistical data which shows that Black doctors face a disproportionate number of sanctions when compared to white physicians and that the maternal and infant mortality rates for Black women and children are still much higher than their white counterparts
