Nagy, 2007 How General Washington Avoided the Peril From Within His Own Forces It gives me great pain to be obliged to solicit the attention of the honorable Congress to the state of the army the greater part of the army is in a state not far from mutiny I know not to whom to impute this failure but I am of the opinion if the evil is not immediately remedied and more punctuality observed in future the army must absolutely break up George Washington September 1775 Mutiny has always been a threat to the integrity of armies particularly under trying circumstances and since Concord and Lexington mutiny had

been the Continental Army's constant traveling companion. It was not because the soldiers lacked resolve to overturn British rule or had a lack of faith in their commanders. It was the scarcity of food during winter months; it was not uncommon for soldiers to subsist on a soup of melted snow, a few peas, and a scrap of fat. Money, clothing, and proper shelter forced soldiers to desert or organize resistance. Mutiny was not a new concept for George Washington. During his service in the French and Indian War, he had tried men under his command for the offense, and he knew that disaffection and lack of morale in an army was a greater danger than an armed enemy.
