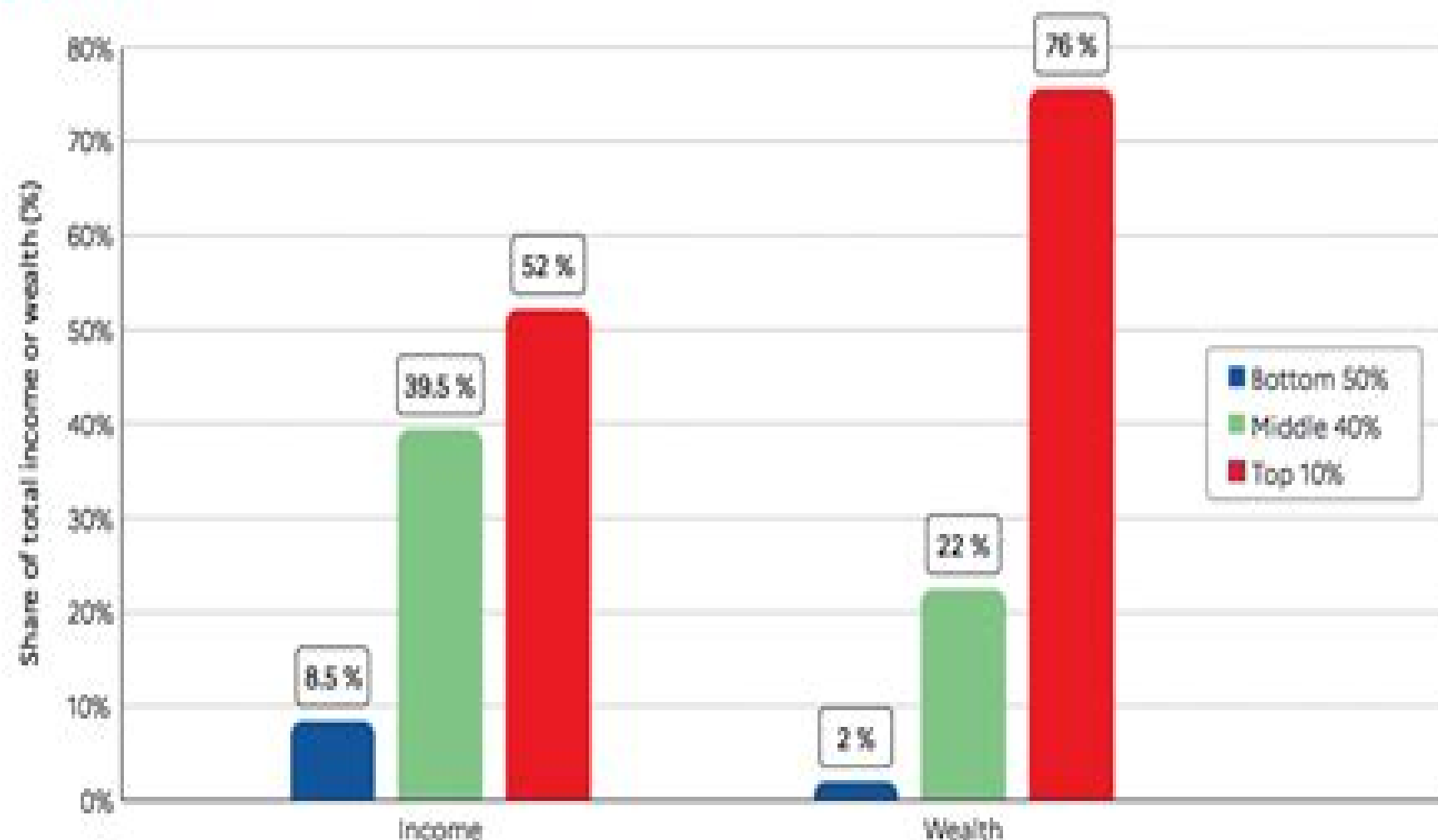


**Figure 1** Global income and wealth inequality, 2021
