first came with the book *Human All too Human* to which this second preface and apology¹ is dedicated As a book for free spirits it shows some trace of that almost cheerful and inquisitive coldness of the psychologist who has behind him many painful things that he keeps under him and moreover establishes them for himself and fixes them firmly as with a needle point Is it to be wondered at that at such sharp ticklish work blood flows now and again that indeed the psychologist has blood on his fingers and not only on his fingers
