Over the course of a hundred years, peasant tactics and political discourse evolved in a constant dialogue with the changing political climate, shifting from rhetorical statements of loyalty to the king to proclamations of federalism and their rights as citizens. **A Nation of Villages** ably demonstrates that rural villagers were more aware of elite ideologies than urban rulers were of the villagers' political ideas.
