With a few exceptions—and they are, like Robert Penn Warren, Allen Tate, and Conrad Aiken, very pleasing ones—contemporary American poets have seldom been novelists, too. Such instincts and talents seem to belong more naturally and generally to English poets, who often write serious fiction or turn, as C. Day Lewis and Julian Symons have done with so much success, to the detective novel. It was with some anticipation, therefore, that I began reading Louis Simpson's Riverside Drive, which is the first novel of a poet who has already published three substantial volumes of lyric verse. Unfortunately, I was forced to conclude that a new book of Mr. Simpson's poetry would have been a much happier literary event.

Riverside Drive narrates some of the life and most of the loves of a young man born, as the author was, in Jamaica who subsequently comes to America to live, receive his higher education, and to work. The book covers a number of years of the protagonist's young manhood, carries him through World War II and a mental breakdown following on it. Woven about these experiences, and his schooling and jobs as well, is the story of his relationship with women—most particularly with one girl whom he meets in the opening pages of the novel. At the novel's finish the protagonist has abandoned the girl, New York, his attempts to be a writer, and has settled with a wife in a modest home and occupation in
