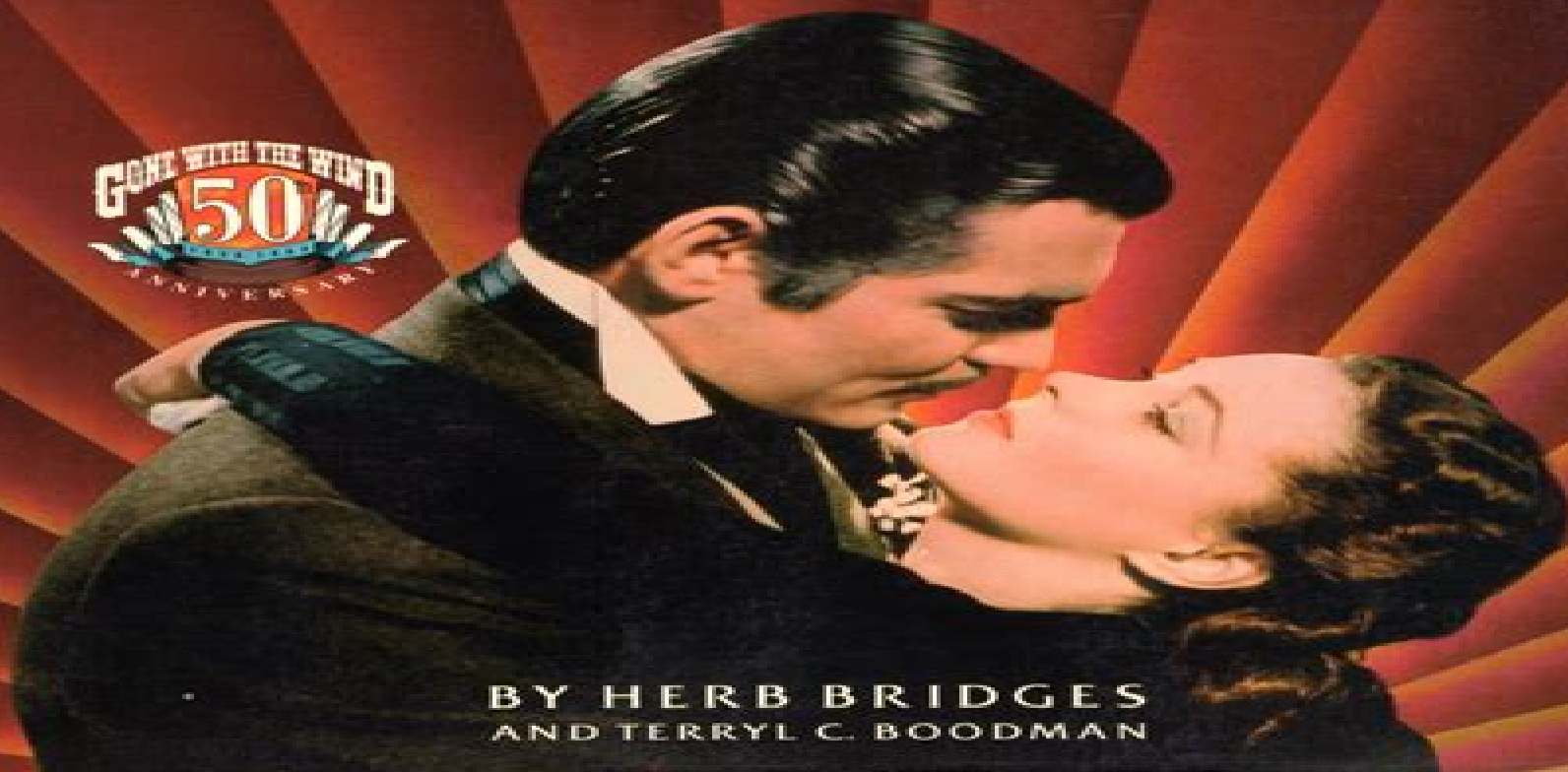

Jonesboro Historical Jonesboro/Clayton County Inc, 2007 Pioneers came to the Jonesboro area originally known as Leaksville following the Treaty of Indian Springs with the Creek Indians In 1845 the Macon and Western Railroad was

completed and the town was renamed in honor of engineer Samuel Jones. It was designated the county seat when Clayton County was formed in 1859 and was soon a commercial center for the surrounding area. Jonesboro was developed around the railroad and these rails brought the Yankees here for the last and decisive battle of the Atlanta Campaign during the Civil War which destroyed much of the town.
