This thesis studies the way in which many elements (ideas, etc. etc.) influenced the thought and writing of Thomas Bayle, in particular his two *Grand dictionnaires historiques et critiques*. We study this work in detail, showing the different ways he makes use of several elements, and the way in which he very carefully refers to the examples which bear out his arguments. Much more of the world is explained in a specific way - for example the New Testament is quoted almost exclusively in support of arguments on permission and tolerance, whereas the Middle Ages provide material for a greater variety of topics. Bayle gives information about other nations, which he sometimes criticises and ridicules, but more often he uses them to attack European and European prejudices.

We also studied Bayle's other works, throughout which we find a constant evolution in his like sentences and explanations of several elements. In the early works of the 1680s he shows an interest in a fairly limited way - they provide him with a constant supply of ideas and arguments, which, however, he does not develop in any great degree. As his writing progresses, though, we see him combining several elements more and more, and explaining fully the considerations involved.

Finally, we place Bayle's set of great elements in context by comparing them with other seventeenth-century writers, studying the frequency with which journals of the time mentioned others and by looking at lists of other published during this period. We realise, for example, that not only is he quite different from other writers in the content of his lists of great elements, but also that his use of this element reflects basically the content and type of other periods.
