Group in October 1944 for a second tour and was again assigned to the 8th Fighter Squadron He arrived when his squadron was converting to P 38 Lightnings in preparation for General Douglas MacArthur's return to the Philippines Sammy recounts hell on earth at Tacloban Airfield on Leyte Island the most difficult and dangerous days of the entire war for the pilots and personnel of the 49th Fighter Group His memoirs take the reader through the Philippines campaign to Okinawa and finally the surrender of Japan Flying Magazine ,1959-05 Historic Aircraft Wrecks of San Bernardino County G.
