Van Devender, 2019-04-15 One of the most recognizable animals of the Southwest the desert tortoise *Gopherus agassizii* makes its home in both the Sonoran and Mohave Deserts as well as in tropical areas to the south in Mexico Called by Tohono O odham people *komik c ed* or shell with living thing inside it is one of the few desert creatures kept as a domestic pet as well as one of the most studied reptiles in the world Most of our knowledge of desert tortoises comes from studies of Mohave Desert populations in California and Nevada However the ecology physiology and behavior of these northern populations are quite different from those of their southern Sonoran Desert and tropical cousins which have been studied much less Differences in climate and habitat have shaped the evolution of three races of desert tortoises as they have adapted to changes in heat rainfall and sources of food and shelter as the deserts developed in the last ten million years This

The Ópatas David Yetman, 2010-11-15. In 1600 they were
